

Deadline Applications – 5 May 2017
Offer letters sent out by – 29 May 2017
Deposit on Fees (€1000) – 5 June 2017
Project Proposal Seminar Week – 12-16 June 2017
Tuition fees due – 1 September 2017
Further dates will be circulated among successful applicants.

Places:

Number of places 2017: 15
There are 15 places available in the 2017/18 academic year.
The option for lwb alumni to enrol on the MA will remain available for the foreseeable future.

Application Process

Your application, which can be emailed, should include the following;

- Completed Postgraduate application form
- CV
- Reference from lwb (to be sent directly from lwb faculty to IADT faculty)
- Non Academic/Industry reference letter
- lwb Certificate
- Draft Project Proposal

A hard copy of the above should be sent for filing.
You may include supporting information with your application; a digital portfolio, links etc.

IADT Client Briefs:

IADT will release Client briefs/challenges on 21 April.
You are welcome to respond to these briefs or propose a project of your own.

Assessment Process:

Following the deadline, your application and draft proposal(s) will be reviewed (please note that further information may be requested following the application deadline). Places on the MA will first be offered to current students at the lwb, pending graduation and proposal submitted. Remaining places will be offered to alumni based on the quality of the application and proposal. If you have not been successful at assessment stage, an email notifying you of this decision will be sent out by 29 May 2017.

FAQs:

Can I select my final project supervisors? You will be assigned a supervisor(s). Depending on your proposal, external supervisors can be made available.
