- 4. Climate change and renewable energy


WEAKNESSES

- Social and physical interaction / connection is very low
- Need for a health center
- Lack on the freedom to pursue interests and prosperity
- The access to food and source of health is very low
- Industrial and financial frameworks are not well developed
- The social life, habits or traditions, adopted by the residents is low
- The identity of the neighborhood is not defined
- Lack on application of techniques, tools or skills that can be used to develop a systematic objective

- Design infill buildings for an aging population
- Repurpose schools
- Propose agricultural solutions
- Connect the site to Plum Tree Park
- Propose connections to regional GO networks
- Repurpose recreational facilities
